

HFA Dress Code Policy

Please keep the following information to reference when you have a question about the dress code on a particular day. The following information will be required of every student who attends Holy Family Academy. Please read this policy carefully so that you are sure to have the necessary clothing for the school year.

School Uniforms – The school uniform is worn most days during the school year. The school uniform is mandatory for boys and girls. **There is no deviating from these guidelines.**

Girls-Grades K-8

Polo shirt- White or Navy Blue, long or short sleeve embroidered with the HOLY FAMILY ACADEMY logo. **Shirts are to be tucked in.**

Sweater (optional)- Navy Blue V-neck pullover or cardigan embroidered with the HOLY FAMILY ACADEMY logo.

Uniform Pants or Skorts- Khaki or Navy Blue

Uniform Shorts- Khaki or Navy Blue (may be worn Aug.-Oct. and Apr.-Jun.)

Plaid Jumper- Grades K-4 purchased through Flynn O'Hara or Lands End

Plaid Skirt- Grades 5-8 purchased through Flynn O'Hara or Lands End

Socks or Tights- White, Navy Blue or Tan

Shoes- Brown, Tan, Black, Navy or Grey

- Shoes can be slip on or have laces and should be solid color w/ NO design
- NO BOOTS; NO SANDELS or SLIDES (including Crocs)
- Athletic sneakers are permitted on assigned Gym days, Spirit days or Dress Down days

Boys-Grades K-8

Polo shirt- White or Navy Blue, long or short sleeve embroidered with the HOLY FAMILY ACADEMY logo. **Shirts are to be tucked in.**

Sweater (optional)- Navy Blue V-neck pullover or cardigan embroidered with the HOLY FAMILY ACADEMY logo.

Uniform Pants- Khaki or Navy Blue

Uniform Shorts- Khaki or Navy Blue (may be worn Aug.-Oct. and Apr.-Jun.)

Cargo shorts /pants are not allowed.

Socks- Navy Blue or Tan

Shoes- Brown, Tan, Black, Navy or Grey

- Shoes can be slip on or have laces and should be solid color w/ NO design
- NO BOOTS; NO SANDELS or SLIDES (including Crocs)
- Athletic sneakers are permitted on assigned Gym days, Spirit days or Dress Down days

PreK-Uniform- boys and girls wear the HFA Gym Uniform daily and can wear slip on or athletic sneakers. NO BOOTS; NO SANDELS or SLIDES (including Crocs)

HFA Gym Uniform- Students in grades K-8 wear the gym uniform on designated gym day.

- Short sleeve navy gym t-shirt with HFA logo
- Navy sweatpants with HFA logo
- Navy mesh shorts with HFA logo (shorts may be worn Aug.-Oct. and Apr.-Jun.)
- Any HFA logo sweatshirt
- Athletic sneakers and white socks

AT NO TIME ARE STUDENTS PERMITTED TO WEAR ATHLETIC TIGHTS UNDER THEIR SHORTS

Spirit Days- Two Spirit Days are scheduled during each month. (see school calendar) These days are designed to allow students to show their school spirit by wearing HFA logo clothing

- Any long or short sleeve shirt with HFA logo
- Navy Blue Mesh shorts with HFA logo (shorts may be worn Aug.-Oct. and Apr.-Jun.)
- Any sweatshirt with HFA logo

JEANS, YOGA PANTS, LEGGINGS OR ATHLETIC TIGHTS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON SPIRIT DAY

Dress Down Days - Dress down days are used as rewards for students throughout the year. On these days, students may wear their favorite clothing to school. All clothing must be appropriate in size for the school setting. NO skirts /dresses of an inappropriate length, tight fitting stretch or yoga pants, low-neck shirts or dresses, halter tops/crop tanks or tank tops allowed to be worn. Jeans are allowed on dress down days.

Dress Up Days (Birthday/Picture Days) - During the school year there are days where students may be out of normal school uniform but are still required to dress up. These days include birthdays and some picture days. On these days, students are allowed to wear the following:

- Dress pants of any color
- Sweater of any color
- Knee length skirts, dresses or shorts for girls
- Jeans, sweatpants, and yoga pants are NOT allowed on dress up days. No skirts or dresses of inappropriate length, as well as low-neck shirts or dresses, halter/crop tops or tank tops.

In addition the following dress code will be applied:

- Boys must be clean-shaven; their hair must be clean, neatly combed, and cut above the collar and behind the ears and eyebrows must be visible.
- Girls may not wear makeup or excessive jewelry. Piercings (other than traditional earrings) are not permitted. Boys may not wear any unusual jewelry – no earring or necklaces (which are visible) Boys may not wear pierced jewelry of any kind. Hats may not be worn in the building.
- Unusual haircuts and/or hair color are not permitted for boys and girls.
